


Grading a Standards Based Assignment in FACTS SIS

Prior to Grading Standards for an Assignment you will First Need to Assign a Grade

There are two ways to Enter Grades.


1. Enter Individual Grades Manually. Select Grade Field for each student under Assignment and enter Grade. Changes will Save automatically.


2. Fill Grades. In this option you enter one grade for all students than change only those that are different




2. Calculate Standards Mastery Across All Assignments within a Subject
